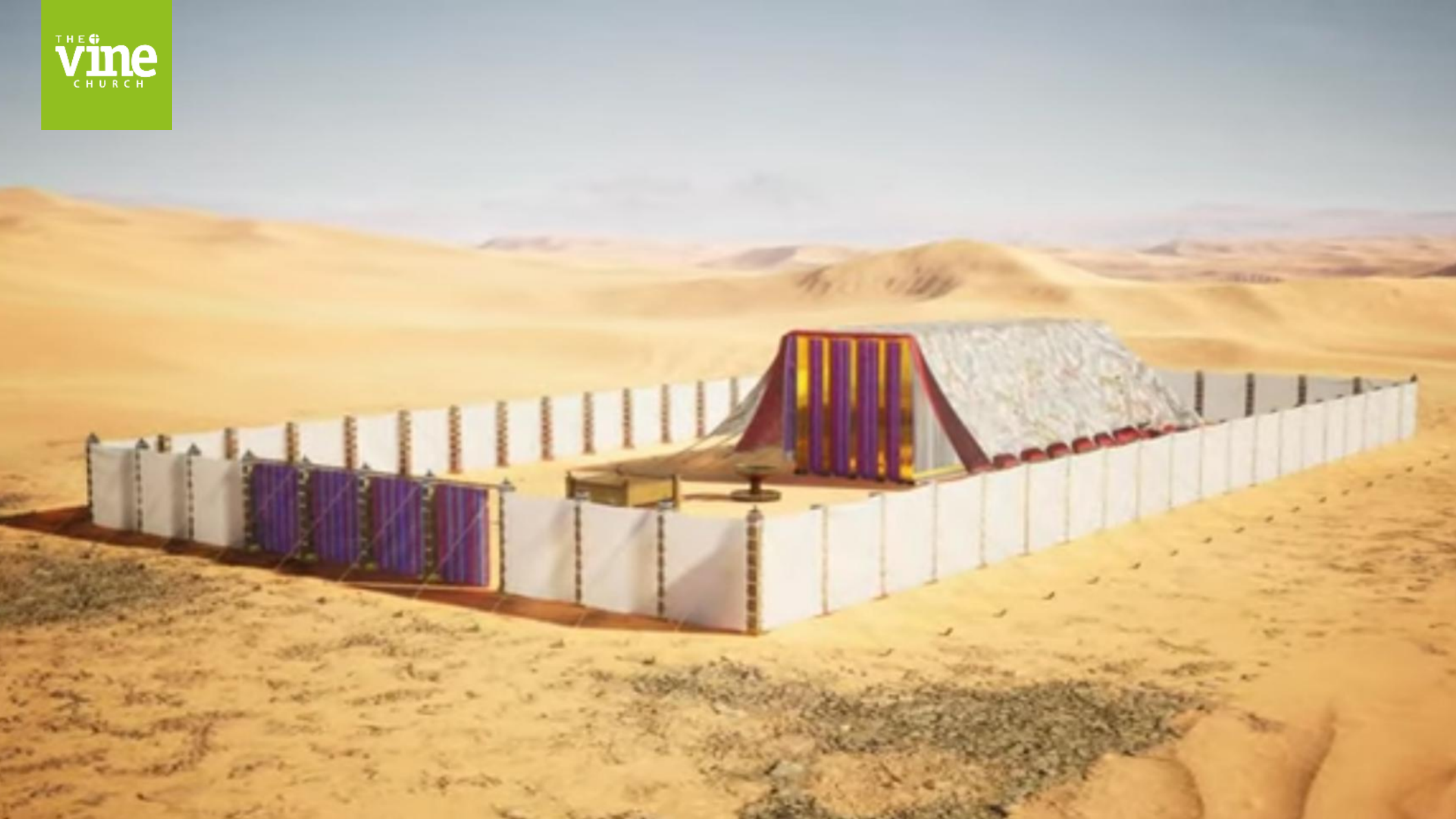

Voluntary:

- Burnt Offerings
- Grain & Drink Offerings
- Peace Offerintgs
