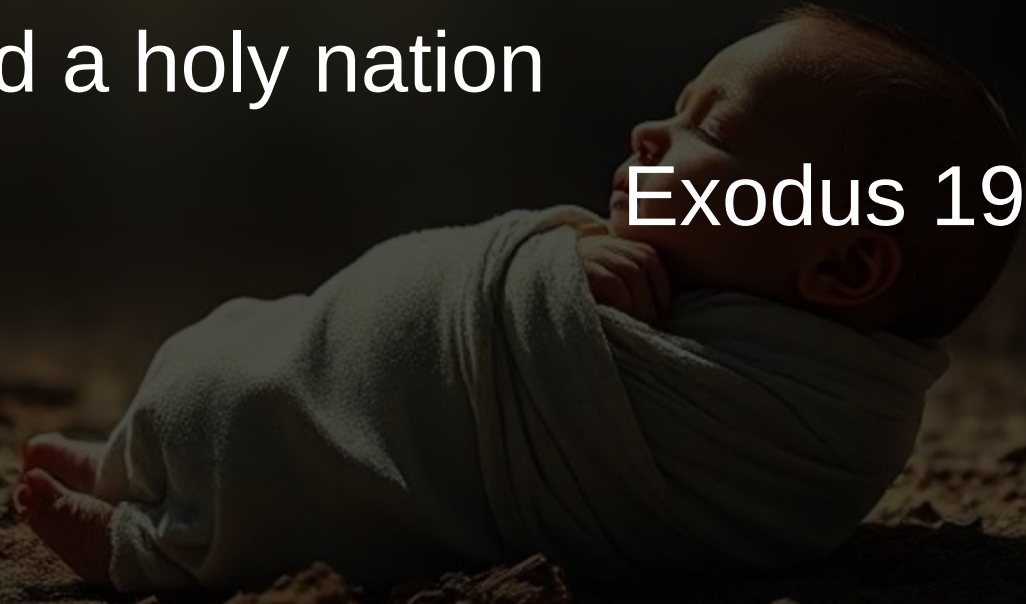

The Fulfilment Is Born



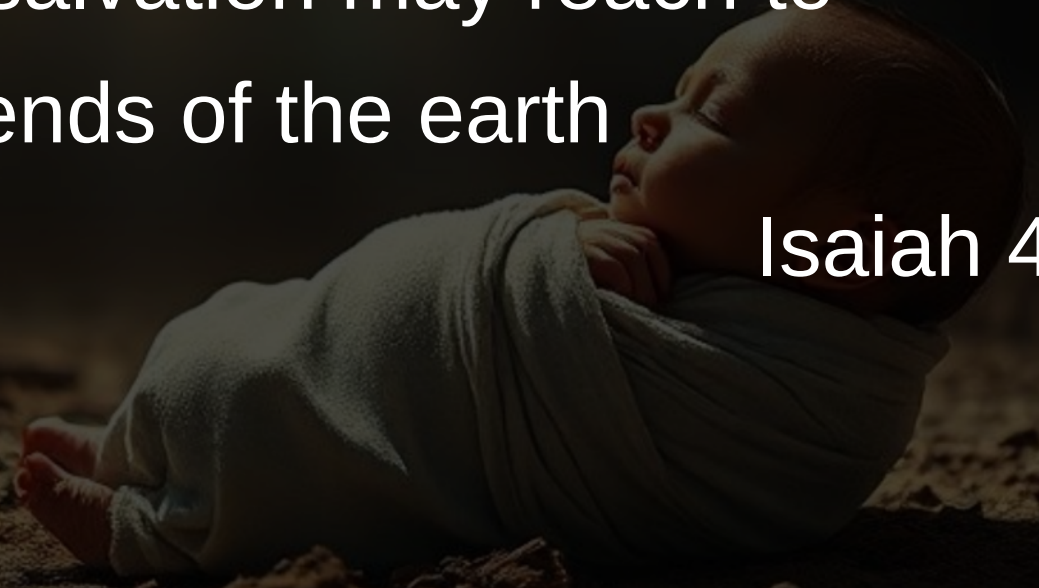

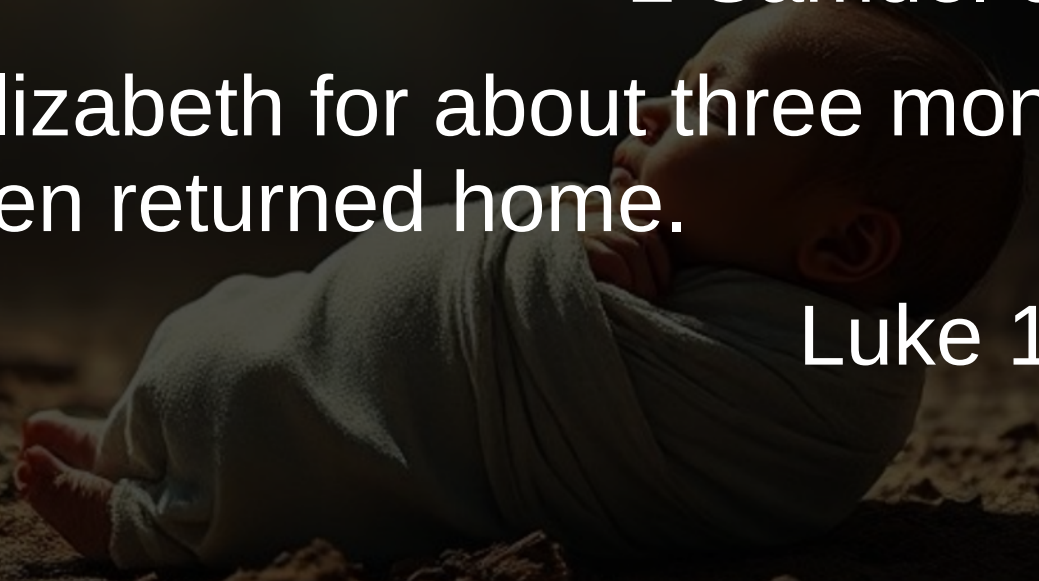


The ark of the Lord remained in the house of

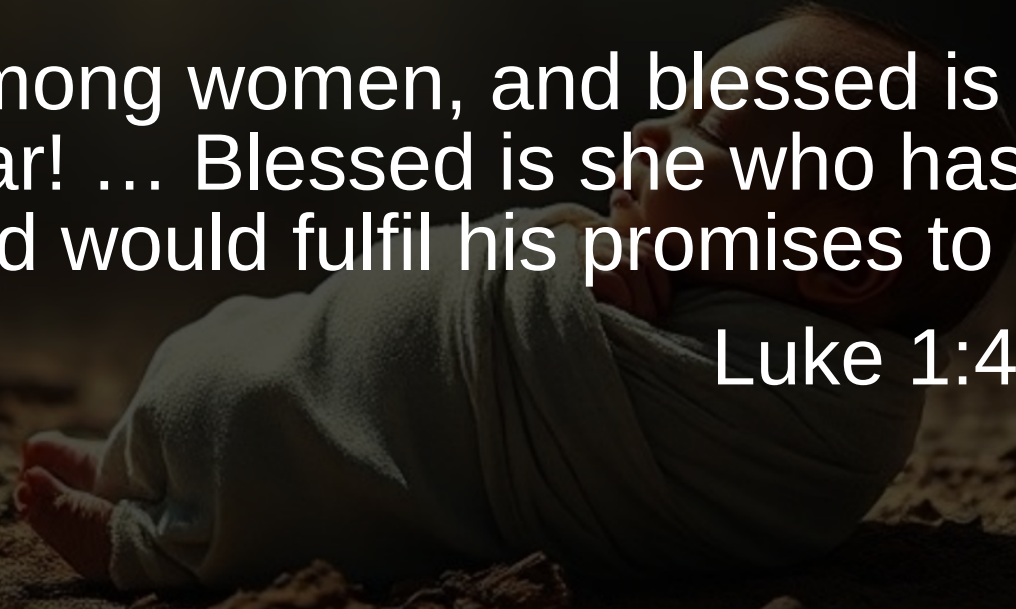

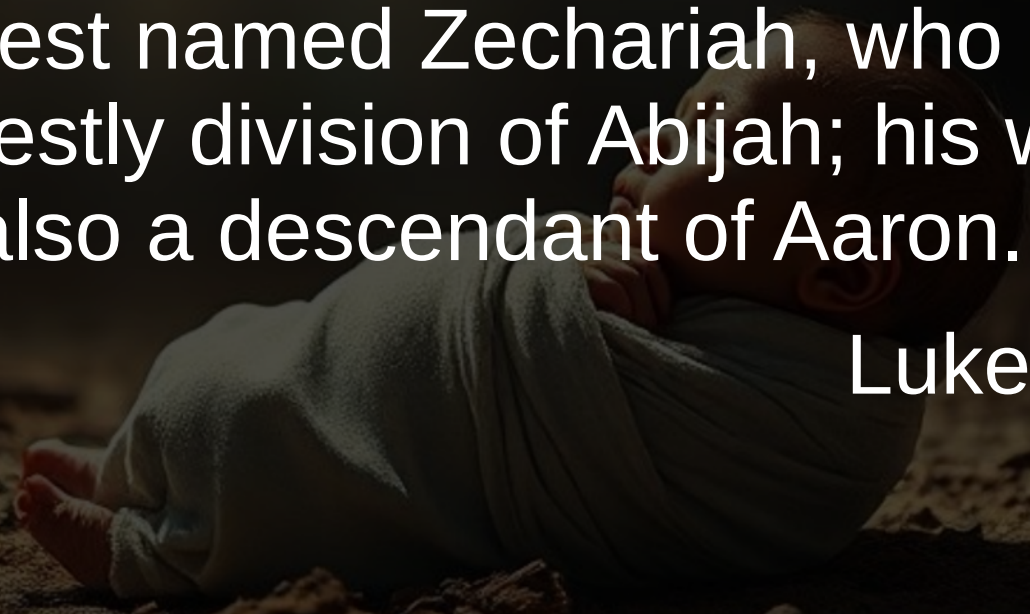


[David was] Wearing a linen ephod

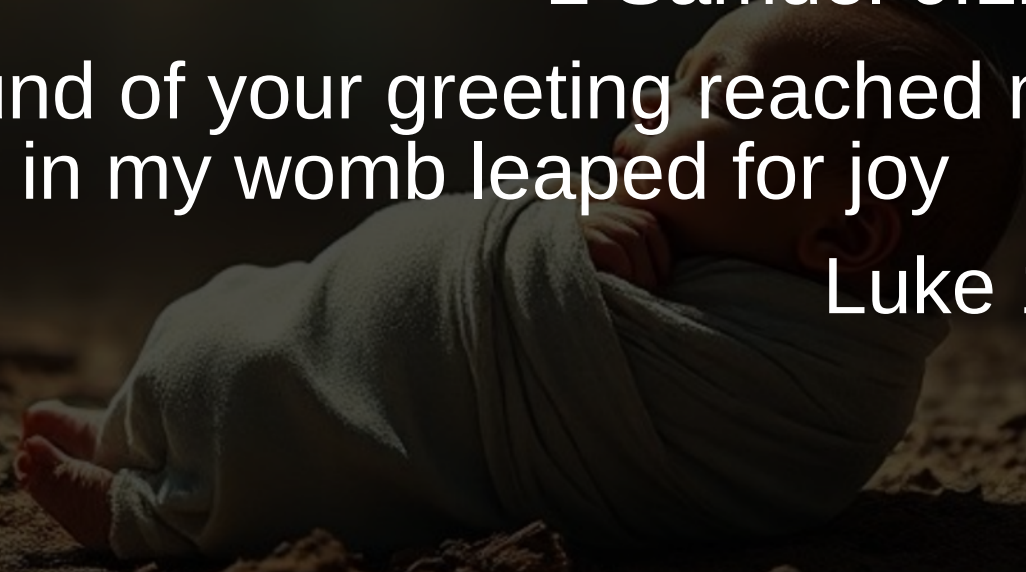


David went to bring up the ark of God... with rejoicing.
