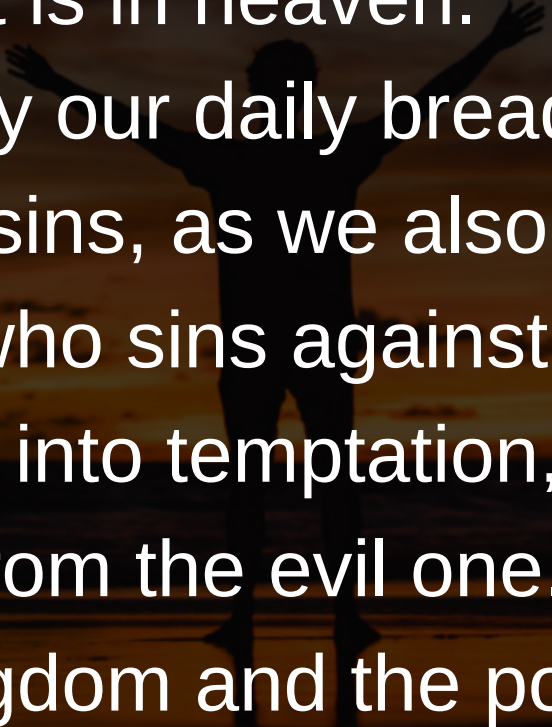

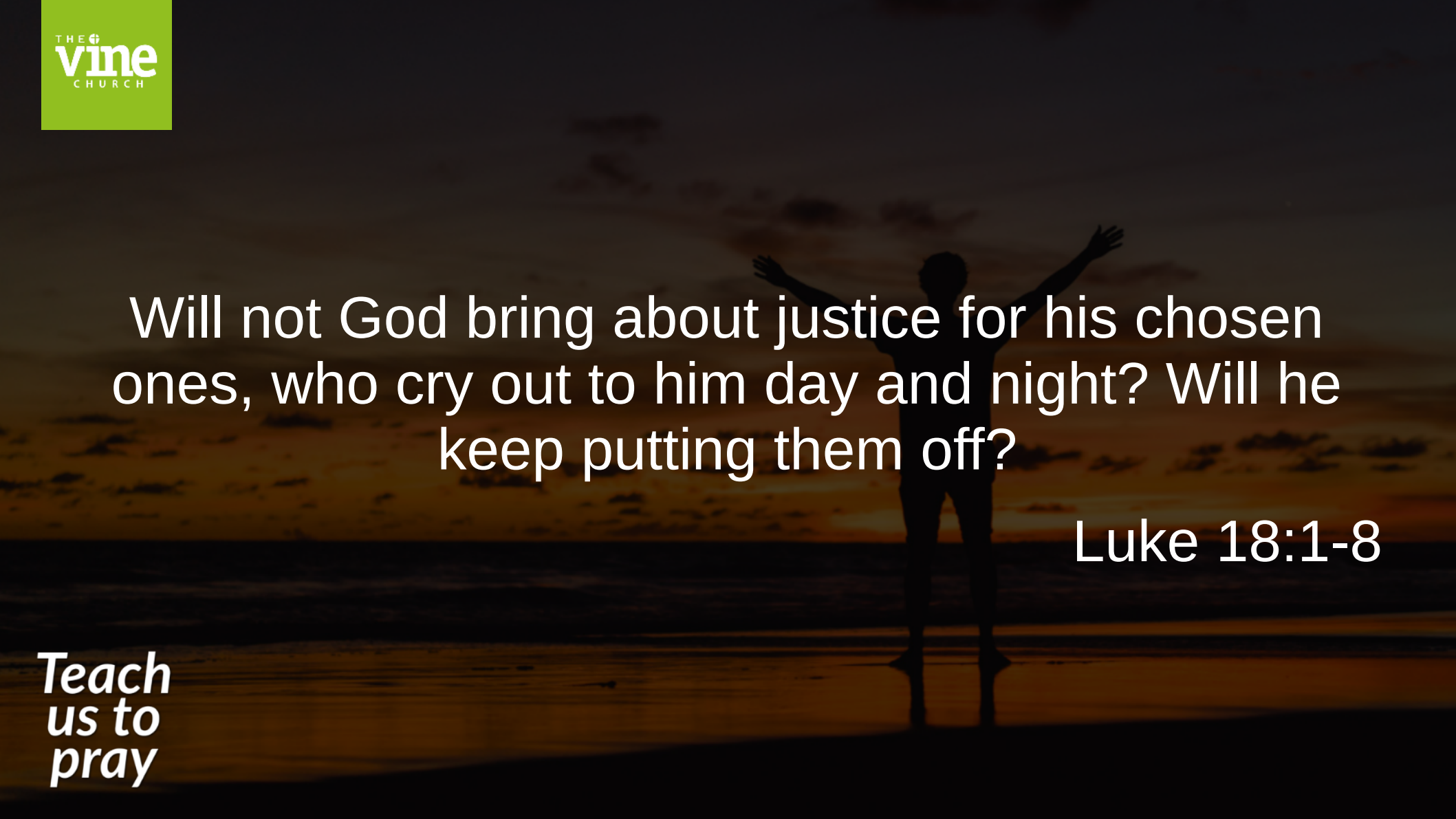

Will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off?

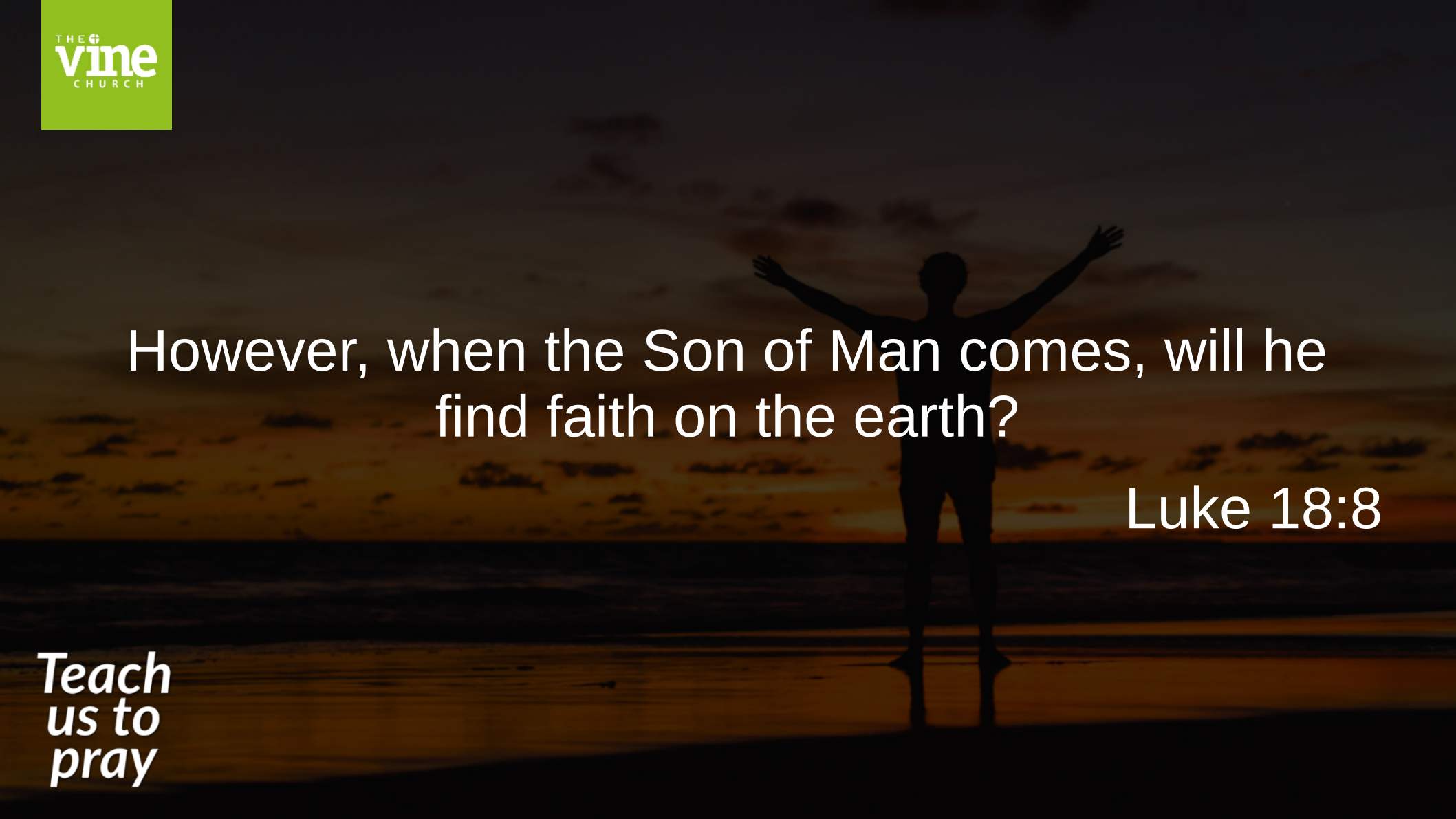

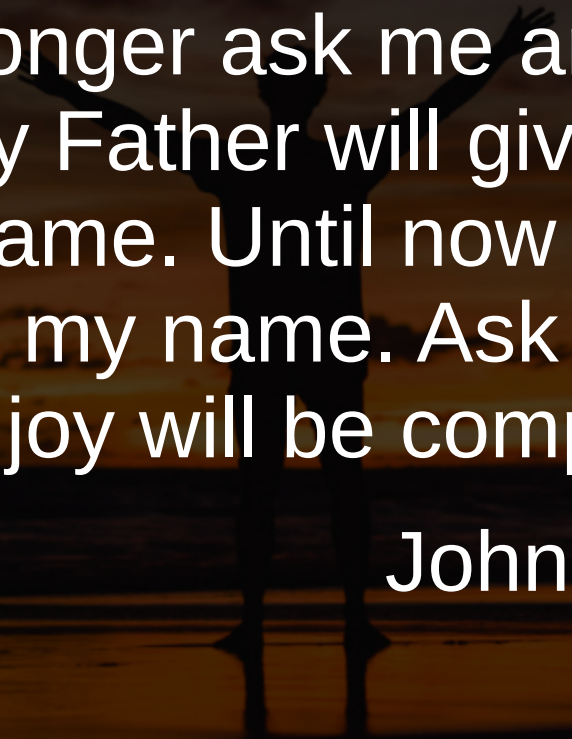

will receive, and your joy will be complete.

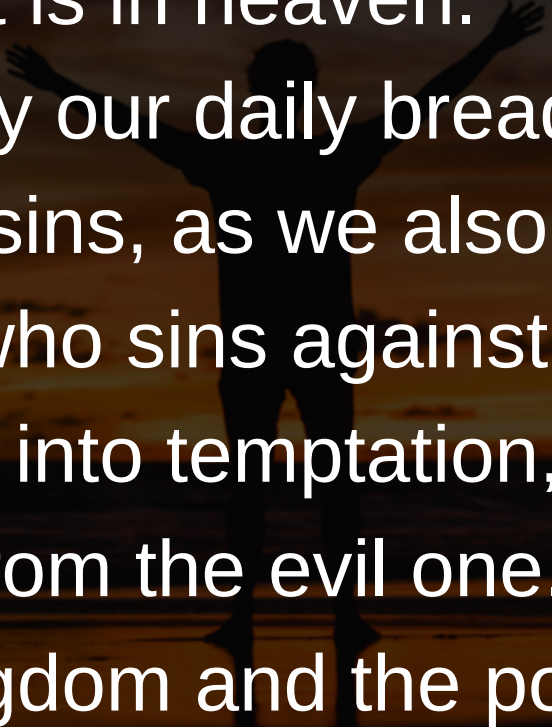
